Subject: Radio theft

This past Tuesday evening (4/3) we had a theft at Skyhaven Airport. Two Garmin 430Ws were stolen out of a Cirrus aircraft. The individual appears from the video to be very familiar with aircraft and airports. Looked like he had a routine, like he works on airplanes every day. Possibly even an A&P or Avionics tech. He targeted the exact hangar and walked right past other aircraft to go directly to the Cirrus. He had a tool kit with just the right tools and was in and out of a locked T-hangar with two NavComs and an Audio Panel in under five minutes. He also knew exactly where our security cameras were, and even where the security cameras our T-Hangar tenant had installed were.

I wanted to give you a heads up. Due to the proximity of our airfields, it is reasonable to assume that this individual could be targeting Sanford Airport as well. The Rochester Police Department is investigating this incident. This is the second reported theft at Skyhaven in three months. The first was a report of headsets stolen from an unlocked Cessna on the tie-down ramp. I'll be reaching out to Mark and Jim at Southern Maine as well to be on the lookout and looking for anyone trying to sell a couple of 430s.

Please let me know if you hear of anything that could help find this guy and do not hesitate to call me if I can be of assistance.
