There is normally about 30 - 40 "vendors" that attend and about 1500 people that drive or fly in. Biplane and Helicopter rides are available. Light Sport aircraft dealers for Sport Cruiser, Flight Design CTS, and Legend Cub will be represented. All are welcome.

The EAA chapter on our airport puts on a pancake breakfast starting a 8AM and our Airfield Cafe is open all day for breakfast & lunch. There ar many eating establishments on US Route 1.

This is a 2 day event with no rain date. Obviously the best weather day will bring the highest turn out.
