SNOW REMOVAL SEASON

We are poised to enter the 2003 - 2004 snow removal season at the Skyhaven Airport. The following are reminders for everyone to consider and follow during the coming winter season:

- Please give the snow removal contractor time and space to clear the airport surfaces. Minimize the use of private vehicles on the airport aprons during the snow removal operations. Please yield to snow removal equipment.
- The airport bucket loader is equipped with Unicom radio capability (122.7). For aircraft movements, ground or airborne, announce your intentions, and if need be specifically address the equipment operator to insure he understands your intentions.
- No long-term vehicle parking on airport property. If you have a
 hangar please park your vehicle in the hangar when departing
 on an extended flight during the snow season. If you have a tie
 down space, please park your vehicle within your space and not
 in the taxi-lane. If neither of these apply please contact OVA
 and make arrangements for extended parking outside the airport
 fence.
- The snow removal contractor will remove snow to within 5 feet or less of the hangars. The contractor will attempt to accommodate those wishing to arrive or depart the airfield immediately following a snow event.

The Division of Aeronautics thanks you in advance for your cooperation during this snow season. Remember the contractor's task is to make the airport safe for your use. Give him the time and the support necessary to accomplish the task.
